It is the policy of Realm to identify and manage the environmental, social and economic impacts within our supply chain.

We are committed to:

- Setting objectives and action plans in support of this policy, and pursuing continuous improvement of our practices
- Prioritising suppliers who have embedded safe, sustainable and ethical practices within their organisation and who demand similar standards within their own supply chain
- Complying with statutory legislation and good working practice

Through the development of a supplier procurement strategy and engagement with Clients and stakeholders, we will look to use suppliers that actively:

- Put in place procedures and take positive steps to mitigate risk and carry out their activities in a safe and risk averse manner
- Reduce their environmental footprint through optimal use of resources, including energy, water and materials
- Seek to minimise waste both within their operations and through reduction of packaging
- Reduce the impact of deliveries and maximise local sourcing as far as reasonably practical

In adopting a Sustainable Procurement Policy we will help deliver benefits to society through:

- Complying with recognised standards and principles in respect of human rights and conditions of employment
- Ensuring that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place in any of our supply chains and in any part of our business

We will help drive economic growth through:

- Supporting job creation and facilitating opportunities for businesses who operate in the communities served by our shopping centres.
- Considering the life-cycle cost of products and services we consume
- Collaborating with our Clients that the Real Living Wage (at a minimum) be paid to employees and contractors engaged to provide a service or working on their assets

In conjunction with our Clients' procurement policies It will be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure it retains relevance in the context of our business activities. We will also monitor compliance and seek to identify opportunities to deliver continual improvement.
